The NYSDEC published its Environmental Notice Bulletin that that proposes an allowable concentration in ambient air for PFOA of 0.0053 µg/m3. The concentration level is called an annual guideline concentration (AGC) only pertains to PFOA, which has led some critics to claim that the proposed regulation does not go far enough, since PFOA have largely been phased out from use in the United States. Instead, critics argue, the regulation should have encompassed more of the over 7,000 PFAS compounds to account for the vast number of recently created PFAS that are more widely used today in industrial settings. Essentially there are no emissions standards that exist in NYS. How will you ensure you are not harming us as there are really no guardrails at this time for emissions?
